What are the language requirements?

Language requirements

Prior to 2015

English language requirements apply to International applicants and other applicants whose previous study was undertaken in a language other than English. The minimum English language requirements for such applicants for entry to this program are as follows:

- A minimum overall band score of 6.0 on IELTS (Academic) with no sub-score of less than 5.5
- *OR* a minimum score of 550 on TOEFL
- *OR* an internet-based (iBT) TOEFL score of 79 (no score less than 19)

- *OR* no score less than 3 in each skill of the ISLPR (conducted by ISLPR Language Services only)
- *OR* a minimum overall score of 169 (no score less than 162) on C1 Advanced (formerly Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English) **or** C2 Proficiency (formerly Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English)
- *OR* an overall score of 54 in the Pearson Test of English (Academic) with a minimum of 46 in all Communicative Skills.

English test results must be no more than two years old.

Students who successfully complete the **Direct Entry Program (DEP)** will satisfy the English Language requirements for this Griffith degree.
