The Bachelor of Design Futures (Honours) program provides a pathway to research higher degrees with direct entry into

doctoral programs for students who graduate with First Class Honours. It would also enable gifted graduates to be eligible to apply for scholarships and awards.

## What are the fees?

### Commonwealth supported students

### Fee-paying undergraduate (domestic) students

These fees are only applicable to domestic students who are not Commonwealth supported including:

- Full-fee paying domestic students who commenced their program prior to 2009.
- International students who have been approved to pay domestic tuition fees after obtaining Australian or New Zealand citizenship or permanent residency or a permanent humanitarian visa and who have not obtained a Commonwealth supported place.

### Tuition fees
